Types of comparison websites


- **Directories** listings of providers who may pay a basic fee to be listed or a larger fee for an enhanced listing.
- Feedback websites allow previous clients to provide feedback on their experience for others to read and often incorporate a scoring mechanism such as a star rating.
- Referral websites the website collects basic information about the consumer's needs and passes the lead to one or more provider.
- Price comparison website allowing consumers to instantly compare and make a choice between subscribing providers against defined criteria such as price.
